Connect with Each Other:

Icebreakers

You can use these questions to break the ice in conversations as you start your group.

- What is your favorite moment in sports history?
- What small act of kindness did someone do for you this week?

Pray Together

- Praying for our team (family, church, friends) and for those who do not know Jesus and the sacrifices that He made for them. Pray for someone or a group of people that you would not ordinarily pray for and especially for your enemies.

Connect with God:

Message Summar

You may want to ask a group member to recap the message so everyone is ready to discuss the message, especially if some people missed gathering that weekend. If people are having a hard time remembering, you can use this summary to help give a recap.

- **Sticky statement:** Grace, truth, and sacrifice are how we bring the peace of God into this world.
- **Message Summary:** This weekend's movie was the story of Jackie Robinson. Pastor Mark uses the movie to illustrate that facing adversity sometimes requires stepping up and doing what we are called to do, pursuing our purpose. Following Jesus opens doors, but we decide if we will step through the door and use the opportunities to make a difference in God's kingdom. We are called to assume the best of others, being courageously faithful in our everyday life, and sacrificing our preferences and comfort for what God wants.
