General Description: Provides vision, leadership, and direction for the Worship Team. Leads J-Team in cultivating a life-giving, passionate, skillful culture of music and worship at The Journey. Plans and implements music for all weekend gatherings and events. Oversees the structures and systems of the worship team.

- Consistently practices all public habits (gathering on a weekend, connecting in a J-Group, serving on the J-Team) and personal habits (investing & inviting, practicing a slot & spot, giving your first)
- At least three years experience serving and succeeding (based on core value analysis) in a leadership role at The Journey or another similar environment, exhibiting above-average creativity and initiative and the ability to consistently motivate and lead self and others
- Healthy relationships with existing staff and leaders (in current position and/or at The Journey)
- Proficiency in vocals and guitar and/or keys
- Ability to lead a worship experience with a team
- Able to identify, develop, and empower others to lead
- A demonstrable calling to ministry

Essential Functions:

- Develops leaders and builds teams to lead worship at current and future locations of The Journey
- Oversees and empowers the worship core team to develop and implement the vision for music and worship at The Journey
- Raises up musicians through the Infuse process; coaches and prepares them for the weekend stage
- Develops and maintains the structures and systems of the Worship Team; utilizes Planning Center to create worship sets and communicate with leaders and team members
- Responsible for developing quality, life-giving worship sets at all locations
- Maintains budgets for area and is a wise financial steward of all funds
- Performs other leadership functions as assigned

General Responsibilities:

- Participates in weekly department meetings and monthly all-staff meetings
- Attends weekend gatherings (gather during one, serve during others), lead a J-Group at least two out of three semesters, and serves in some way outside of essential functions
- Champions gather, connect, and serve
