General Description: Assists Central Worship Director in creating an atmosphere in which people can experience God through quality worship. Relentlessly empowers -- identifies, builds, and develops musicians and vocalists for location worship team.

- Consistently practices all public habits (gathering on a weekend, connecting in a J-Group, serving on the J-Team) and personal habits (investing & inviting, practicing a slot & spot, giving your first)
- Likeable and fun to be around
- Abnormally high work ethic (an executor who makes things happen on a regular basis)
- Healthy relationships with existing staff and leaders (in current position and/or at The Journey)
- A demonstrable calling to ministry
- Proficiency in vocals and guitar and/or keys
- Ability to lead a worship experience with a team
- Ability to provide coaching that elevates the performance of your team
- Ability to identify, develop, and empower leaders

Essential Functions:

Pre-Launch

- Serve on Location Launch Team, assisting Location Pastor and other leaders with developing and mobilizing location launch team and casting vision around location launch
- Gain familiarity with launch team members, establishing and building key relationships.
- Provide coaching and development to location worship staff and leaders; attend regular core team environments to develop leaders and team members and prepare for launch.
- Speak into preparation of the location for launch.

Post-Launch

- Works with Central Worship Director to assist in planning and implementation of set lists
- Oversee recruiting process for Location Worship Team, identifying, developing, and on-ramping new vocalists and musicians for team
- Utilizes Planning Center to schedule worship J-Teamers
- Assists as needed with Infuse, worship team training process
- Additional duties as assigned

General Responsibilities:

- Participate in weekly Gather Team meetings
- Participate in weekly Programming meetings
- Lead worship each weekend
- Attend weekend gatherings
- Practice the personal habits of inviting and investing, slot and spot, and giving your first
- Champion gather, connect, and serve
